## Kikthawenund Scout Camp



Fun and excitement rule at Kikthawenund. During the summer, Webelos Scouts and their parents fill Webelos Adventure Camp, a four-day, three-night, resident camp experience for 9- and 10-year-old boys. During the rest of the year, the 230-acre camp, located 20 minutes north of Noblesville, IN, is available for many other uses.

The beautiful Steak 'n Shake Dining Hall is available year round and can easily accommodate 400 for meals. There are three new, heated bunk-style cabins that each sleep 24. Fun program sites — such as Fort Miami, Dan Beard Tree House, Western Town shelters, Indian Village and the Lake Cherokee Riverboat Shelter — give the camp a special charm. Ten primitive campsites and heated central restrooms are available for use during the school year. Pipe Creek, a White River tributary, runs through the camp.

### Facilities

- Dining hall with kitchen, seats 400
- Meeting room located off dining area, seats 20
- 3 cabins, each cabin is divided into 4 rooms, 1 common room and 3 sleeping rooms each, with 4 bunk beds (each cabin sleeps 24)
- 2 cabins with 10 bunk beds each
- Pool with showers and restrooms (open June 1 – Aug. 31)
- 5-acre boating lake
- 10 camping areas
- 2 large activity fields
- Director's cabin/office (4)
- Welcome shelter
- Cub shelter
- BB range (no firearms)
- Archery area
- Campfire area, seats 200
- Riverboat
- Indian Village, sleeps 45
- Fort Miami, sleeps 20
- Dan Beard Tree House, sleeps 20
