

# Cub Scout Tiger Cub Rank – Advancements

## Introduction

This document should be used as a guideline on the advancement process in the Tiger Cub program. For more information, please refer to the official handbook.



These are the requirements based on the 2001 edition of the Cub Scout Tiger Cub Handbook.

**Note:** Turn to the front page of your handbook and put your name in it. You will need to bring your handbook to every meeting and this will help determine which is yours when they get lost.



## Earning the Belt Totem

The belt totem is used to display the scout's progress towards his Tiger Cub rank. It is worn on the belt with the black paw showing. Your den leader will give the belt totem to you when you can demonstrate that you have learned the following.

## Cub Scout Tiger Cub Rank – Advancements, Continued

### Earning the Totem Beads

To earn the rank of Tiger Cub you must complete all 15 achievements in the handbook (pages 31 – 70). There are 5 achievements in each of the 3 different categories. Once you have completed all 15 achievements, you have earned the rank of Tiger Cub and can turn your belt totem over and place your Tiger Cub patch on the totem.

Bead Color	Categories	Achievements to Complete
White	Family Activity	1F, 2F, 3F, 4F, 5F
Orange	Den Activity	1D, 2D, 3D, 4D, 5D
Black	Go See It	1G, 2G, 3G, 4G, 5G

**Note:** Once you earn a bead you place the bead(s) on one of the four plastic strands. Each strand is for a different color of bead. The 4<sup>th</sup> strand is for the yellow beads that you earn from electives discussed later.



### Electives

You may work on the electives (page 71 – 138) at any time. You should have your parent or guardian sign that you have completed the electives and record the elective number in the back of the book (page 154). Once you have earned the Tiger Cub patch (see *Earning the Totem Beads* section), you can receive a yellow bead for every 10 electives you complete.
